- Seasonal fresh produce from CP's community garden.
- Dietary needs and allergies accommodated when possible.
- Baby supplies, toiletries, and household items when available.
- New winter coats, hats & gloves, and socks.
- Cooking classes twice a year, including a homemade meal and bag of groceries to take home.
- Free meal and childcare provided at most CP programming.
